SERENADING closest to the pace off the inside, challenged with three furlongs to go, repulsed the runner up in midstretch and drew clear under steady urging. MORENA (PER) forwardly placed along the inside, angled out, moved to challenge three wide on the second turn, pressured the winner to the final furlong and held on for the place while not able to stay with the winner late. UNBRIDLED BELLE lost her footing a bit at the start, recovered and was reserved while within striking distance, moved to a challenging position four wide with three furlongs to go, stayed on well to the stretch and tired. BEST LASS broke in the air, set the pace, held on well to the quarter mile marker and gave way. COPPER STATE was outrun.
