SKYRING was sent hard from the start, set the early pace while near the inside, lost the advantage coming to the five-eighths pole, dropped well behind the new leader, raced inside early on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, regained the lead in upper stretch, drew off under a left-handed whip, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. DADDY NOSE BEST was unhurried while racing in the two path, came under urging on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, gained ground into the final furlong and finished with good energy to get the show.
