About 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ MILES. (Turf) (1.48 $\frac{1}{2}$) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 **FAIR GROUNDS H. (GRADE III) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** By subscription of \$150 by Saturday, February 8. \$750 to pass the entry box. \$750 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted by noon on Saturday, February 15 which shall include all fees. \$150,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weights: Saturday, February 15. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum field size for the Fair Grounds Handicap will be determined by rail setting. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Saturday, February 8, 2014, with 31 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth.). POTOMAC RIVER settled at the back of the spread out field, waited behind rivals on the far turn, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, shifted out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong, closed well into the final sixteenth, had the rider lose his whip late and got up at the wire. SKYRING was sent hard from the start, set the early pace while near the inside, lost the advantage coming to the five-eighths pole, dropped well behind the new leader, raced inside early on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, regained the lead in upper stretch, drew off under a left-handed whip, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. DADDY NOSE BEST was unhurried while racing in the two path, came under urging on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, gained ground into the final furlong and finished with good energy to get the show. GENTLEMAN'S KITTEN was hard held while eager early, went four to five wide on the first turn, took the lead near the five-eighths pole while well out in the course, drew off to a sizeable advantage, dropped in late on the backstretch, raced inside on the far turn, shortened stride coming into the stretch, was collared near the three-sixteenths pole and weakened. SLIP AND DRIVE raced inside on the first turn, settled well off the pace in third position, was urged along while inside on the far turn, moved out under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. HARD ACES went three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, moved out under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. UNITARIAN broke out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear while on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and was no factor. (Rail at 0 Feet)
