WISE DAN was bottled up along the inside, slipped through entering the stretch, was bumped and brushed the shrub when SERUNI was guided in to make contact nearing the furlong marker, shook off that one and gamely edged clear through the final yards. LEA attended the pace two wide, waited between rivals leaving the second turn, split horses inside the three-sixteenths pole and continued on willingly. SERUNI set the pace off of the inside, was collared entering the stretch, angled in to tighten up WISE DAN approaching the eighth pole, bumped that rival but was unable to match strides and gave way. DADDY NOSE BEST was allowed to settle three wide, moved up four wide through the second turn to make a mild bid, but flattened entering the stretch and faded. OL ARMY prompted the pace three wide to the stretch and dropped out.
