NEVER STOP LOOKING moved up between rivals early, gave hard chase about three wide mid turn, angled six wide entering the stretch, closed under repeated right handed rousing, collared SMASH AND GRAB near the sixteenth marker, gained a short lead late and prevailed

between rivals. SMASH AND GRAB moved up three wide to engage BAKKEN after a quarter mile, dueled, gained a short lead mid turn, was surrounded from both sides nearing the quarter pole, emerged with a clear lead leaving the eighth pole, met the winner's bid a sixteenth out, kept on valiantly but just wasn't quite good enough. CUTTY SHARK broke a bit slow, settled off the early pace, commenced a wide run leaving

the three eighths pole, shifted out and came seven wide for the drive, closed gamely once straightened and gained on the top pair. KING HENRY, under hard urging saving ground and chasing the pace, edged up inside rivals near the sixteenth pole and kept trying to the wire.

JACK'S IN THE DECK tracked a contested pace four wide, bid to engage the leaders mid turn, dueled outside SMASH IN GRAB from the guarter pole to about mid stretch then faded in the final sixteenth. BAKKEN, urged from the gate to command, set the pace two wide, was met by SMASH AND GRAB near the half mile marker, kept up the pace battle to the quarter pole then steadily gave way. CASTAWAY rated back
