Bay Colt, (Mar), by Elusive Quality - Kobla by Strawberry Road (AUS). Trainer Jerkens A. James. Bred by Edward P. Evans(VA). QUALITY ROAD eased back and outside CASEY'S ON CALL from close quarters entering the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail into

the far turn, moved to gain the lead while still in hand approaching the quarter pole, responded when challenged by DUNKIRK, came out at the

top of the stretch while repulsing the bid from that rival and edged away under pressure. DUNKIRK allowed to settle while racing off the rail, angled five wide on the far turn, made a run to try the winner racing into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival while clearly second best. THEREGOESJOJO stalked the pace three wide, then was being outfinished when checked from between the top ones at the top of the stretch and gave way. STATELY CHARACTER unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and failed to menace while passing tired rivals. SINCERO was steadied on the first turn to avoid running up on rivals, tracked the pace into the far turn, swung out and tired. CASEY'S ON CALL quickly moved to the fore while angling over to the inside, set the pace along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. TOBY

THE COAL MAN tracked the pace along the rail into the far turn, then faded. The rider of THEREGOESJOJO lodged and objection against the riders of QUALITY ROAD and DUNKIRK for alleged interference at the top of the stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.
