DON'T FORGET GIL was well placed early, bid outside after five furlongs to gain a short lead, repused bids from AMERIBELLE and ROCK CANDY leaving the second turn then drew off smartly late while ridden out. AMERIBELLE made a three wide middle move to challenge for the lead out of the second turn, was no match for the winner in the final furlong but was easily second best. ROCK CANDY raced wide much of the trip, bid five wide out of the second turn then weakened in the drive. BRINCA saved ground from the outset, ran up on a tiring rivals' heels into the stretch and had to steady and swing outside then lodged a mild bid once clear. DZIBANCHE chased inside for five furlongs then faded. MISS OCEAN CITY set a moderate pace for six furlongs then tired badly.
