STACELITA (FR) well out in the course proceeding her way down the homestretch, tucked into the two path in time for the run around the first turn, swung three wide departing it, bided time until the half mile pole, picked up the pace gradually advancing towards the front runners, was let out a notch just past the five-sixteenths pole, gearing up for the stretch run, settled into upper stretch and was called upon for a bit more, surged by to take charge during the ensuing furlong, confidently held the others at bay, hand ridden receiving only a solitary shot right handed at the sixteenth pole. DISTORTED LEGACY took up position in midpack soon after the start, was rated near the hedge for the opening mile, angled outward and was asked for a response turning for home, tipped out an additional path a sixteenth later, had the rider lose the whip a few strides past the eighth pole, continued on with good energy to garner place honors, crossing the wire under a vigorous hand ride. DYNASLEW had the front in a flash, showed the way well rated near the two path around the opening bend and for the run down the backstretch as well, was much closer to the hedge upon reaching the far turn, got let out as the pressure intensified approaching the quarter pole, failed to match the winner's strong kick, then got out finished for second. EMERALD BEECH saved ground until the quarter pole, had no rally. GITCHEE GOOMIE off the inside, was released from a firm hold at the five-sixteenths pole, was under encouragement entering the stretch four wide, came up empty. DELUXE accompanied the pacesetter from the outside for the opening mile, folded.
