Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by Pulpit - Wild Vision by Wild Again. Trainer bin Suroor Saeed. Bred by Winchell Thoroughbreds, LLC(KY).

PYRO was outrun for a half after breaking slowly, closed the gap inside nearing the quarter pole, moved out for room while behind a wall of horses at the quarter pole, split rivals while moving to the five path in upper stretch and finished strongly between horses to get up in the final strides. KODIAK KOWBOY was far back for a half while saving ground, swung four wide at the top of the stretch and unleashed a strong late run in the middle of the track to gain the place. READY'S ECHO trailed for a half after breaking slowly, rallied along the rail on the turn, split horses while in traffic in upper stretch, angled to the rail in midstretch and closed strongly in the final seventy yards. MY PAL CHARLIE raced just off the pace between horses for a half, split rivals while rallying in midstretch and weakened in deep stretch. RILEY TUCKER dueled along the rail for a half, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch and weakened from his early efforts. TRUE QUALITY pressed the pace three wide into upper stretch and tired. KEEP LAUGHING raced well back while five wide into upper stretch and lacked a late response. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS checked in tight at the start, gained five wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. GOLD TRIPPI stumbled at the start and was never close thereafter. PEACE CHANT rallied along the rail to threaten in upper stretch, was caught in traffic then split horses to challenge in midstretch and gave way. MULTITUDE dueled outside to the top of the stretch and gave way. LAW ENFORCEMENT lodged a four wide move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out.
