The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers if there are six (6) or more starters. All starters will be guaranteed no less than \$1,000. If only five (5) or less were to start the purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth and 4% to fifth. Any horse that competes in both the Alfred G. Vanderbilt Handicap and the Forego will have their entry fee waived for the Forego. Three Year Olds, 122 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Chestnut Colt, (Feb), by Hear No Evil - Sexy Stockings by Tabasco Cat. Trainer Zito P. Nicholas. Bred by Jacks or Better Farm Inc.(FL).

JACKSON BEND settled well off the pace while under light urging, came under a bit stronger urging while inside early on the turn, moved off the rail while advancing around the five-sixteenths pole, gained quickly into upper stretch, found room between rivals when ESCROW KID drifted out a bit, rallied to the lead passing the furlong marker and drew clear under right hand urging. JERSEY TOWN was rated just off the pace while off the inside, drafted behind the leaders on the turn, shifted four wide approaching the quarter-pole, chased the leaders in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip outside the eighth-pole, loomed a threat into the final furlong but proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. AIKENITE dropped to the rear of the field, settled at the back, was urged while three then four wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to just miss the place. HAMAZING DESTINY dueled on the outside of SIDNEY'S CANDY, came under the whip in upper stretch and tired. GOLDDIGGER'S BOY stumbled at the start but broke relatively with the field, was ridden along towards the rear, went two then three wide on the turn, advanced in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. ESCROW KID chased the dueling leaders on the outside then three wide on the turn, drifted out slightly while tired in upper stretch and gave way. REGAL RANSOM settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, was put to the whip and came up empty. SIDNEY'S CANDY was asked from the start then moved up, dueled on the inside, came under the whip in upper stretch and weakened. RULE BY NIGHT was ridden along on the outside, moved in nearing the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, failed to respond in upper stretch and dropped out.
