BALETTI unhurried while racing along the outside, advanced a bit after being asked for some run around the far turn, angled outward past the three-sixteenths pole, rallied in earnest after being straightened away, closed in rapidly on the frontrunners with long strides, drew along side DYNAMOOR in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, then sustaining his momentum, shot by in deep stretch to prove best. DYNAMOOR reserved while racing off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch, grabbed the front during the run through the furlong grounds, felt the top one's presence leaving the eighth pole, offered resistance briefly, but couldn't keep pace, relinquishing the lead readily during the final seventy yards. BROTHER NICK quickly on the lead, cut the fractions under a good hold towards the inside, felt pressure for the initial time from midway on the far turn, succumbed to that rival in upper stretch, but held well enough to secure the show. STORM PLAY rated stalking the leader three wide around both turns, weakened after turning for home. SAL THE BARBER unhurried within striking distance, came four wide into the lane but lacked a solid stretch response. GRAND COUTURIER (GB) failed to reach a contending position. OPERATION RED DAWN attended the pace from the two path for three-quarters and gave way. INTERPATATION saved ground to no avail.
