1 1/4 MILES. (1.473) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 *FASIG-TIPTON FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH S. (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS*. Free nomination by Saturday, February 12, 2011, \$4,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$240,000; \$80,000 to second, \$40,000 to third, \$20,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth and \$8,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry at a fee of \$20,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or I stakes at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; of a grade III or \$60,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs.; Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Horses finishing first, second or third in the Fountain Of Youth will automatically be nominated to the Florida Derby. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with Also Eligibles. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winnerstn en highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 12, 2011 with 42 nominations. (Clear 79)

SOLDAT quickly moved to the fore while racing off the rail, responded when challenged by EL GRAYLING on the backstretch, eased in on the far turn to continue making the pace, repulsed a bid from TO HONOR AND SERVE on the far turn, came back off the inside entering the stretch and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to remain clear to the wire. GOURMET DINNER bumped with EL GRAYLING at the start, stalked the pace along the inside, angled outside the leaders leaving the far turn and closed to prove second best while unable to get to the winner. TO HONOR AND SERVE stalked the pace three wide, made a run at SOLDAT on the far turn but couldn't stay with that rival and tired in the drive. BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY reserved off the pace after bumping hard with RACING APTITUDE at the start, steadied to avoid running up on SHACKLEFORD on the far turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones. SHACKLEFORD rated off the pace, raced in contention three wide into the far turn, then faltered. RACING APTITUDE bumped soundly with BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY at the start and was not a factor. CASPER'S TOUCH bumped with EL GRAYLING at the start, then steadied while rank in behind the leaders on the first turn and was through after a half mile. EL GRAYLING jostled between rivals at the start, chased the pace, made a run on the backstretch to press the pace outside SOLDAT into the far turn, then faded and was eased in the final eighth.
