MOMENT OF DELIGHT allowed to settle in early stages, dug in along the outside at the head of the lane, finished strongly in deep stretch and was out nodded by HOLYWELL at the wire. LEAP YEAR LUCK lacked speed in the backstretch, steadily gained ground nearing the far turn, drifted out at the head of the lane and gained ground to the wire. AWESOME ICE was unhurried in early stages, gained ground along the inside, raced within striking distance up upper stretch and yielded in

late drive. JAMIE'S DANCER stalked the pace in backstretch, moved up close a furlong left to run and failed to sustain bid in final stages. EVELYN'S DREAM gained ground along the inside and flattened out in deep stretch. HERECOMESMISSKITTY was reserved in the early going and raced near the back, steadily gained ground and continued steady three wide bid in the drive. R SASSY LASS tracked the leader two off the inside in backstretch, inched up closer to the lead with three furlongs left to run and failed to sustain bid in the drive. MISS AMALITA pushed inward at the start, lacked response in late stages and was never a factor. I'M A GOOD LOOKER took the lead at the start, led the way by narrow margins leaving the backstretch, lost the lead at the quarter pole and had nothing left in late stages.
