QUEEN DRAMA rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, eased out and rallied to engage REDBUD ROAD inside the sixteenth pole, then was all out to edge that rival to the wire. REDBUD ROAD chased the pace four wide, moved to take over leaving the turn, then responded gamely when challenged by QUEEN DRAMA in deep stretch and just failed to last. AWESOME BELLE was racing with the pace when caught in tight along the rail entering the turn, continued to save ground to the top of the stretch, angled out and continued on with good courage for the show while unable to stay with the top ones. FOR THE WIN failed to menace. SINNER'S GOLD was not a factor. MONTÉSSA G pressed the pace three wide, responded when headed by REDBUD ROAD leaving the turn, then came in impeding LOTTA LOVIN nearing the eighth pole and tired. LOTTA LOVIN showed speed off the rail to past the quarter pole, then was faltering when checked in the stretch. CURSING CATHY was done early. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY, MONTESSA G WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SEVENTH FOR INTERFERENCE TO LOTTA LOVIN IN THE STRETCH.
