

6 FURLONGS. (1.073) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *FUTURITY S. (GRADE II) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS.* No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race at the Aqueduct spring or Belmont spring/summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 that will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2013. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race, 4 lbs.; maidens, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances.) IN TROUBLE rode the rail down the backstretch, got tipped into the two path once the runner up had settled along the inside route, chased that opponent from the outside, cut into the gap nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch under a drive, continued to make steady progress during the ensuing furlong, snatched away the advantage with about a sixteenth remaining and kicked away, kept busy to the end. CORFU away last in this abbreviated field, albeit by the narrowest of margins, rushed up after getting put to brisk hand urging to grab the early advantage, was guided over to the rail nearing the half mile pole, cut the pace with the closest pursuer, that being IN TROUBLE, only applying a semblance of pressure until a few strides prior to the end of the bend, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before getting asked for his best, began the final furlong with the top one fully latched on, relinquished a sixteenth later, held on well thereafter to secure second. BIG SUGAR SODA two to three wide on the turn, got set down nearing the quarter pole and attempted to rally in unison with an equally-urged-along FINANCIAL MOGUL, lacked the necessary stretch response. FINANCIAL MOGUL rode the rail on the bend, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. SOUND OF FREEDOM failed to menace.
