WHO'S UP stalked a bit off the rail then bid outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead in midstretch, kicked clear under urging and proved best. MARCELLO between horses early, chased outside a rival then inside, came out past midstretch and edged a rival for the place. LUCKY RAVE (GB) three deep early, settled outside a rival then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just got the show. BRIDGETOWN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then dueled along the rail, fought back in midstretch and weakened late. ACE OF ACES (IRE) a bit slow to begin, settled inside then just off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, continued just off the fence in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ALFARABI also broke inward and a bit slowly, settled outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. COLOURSOFTHEGLEN (IRE) angled in and saved ground, fell back some on the backstretch and second turn, continued inside in the stretch and did not rally. SUMMER MOVIE stalked outside then off the rail leaving the backstretch, continued alongside a rival leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
