LADY COHIBA away well, established the pace inside in hand through the first turn, got attended from the outside by MALIBU HOLIDAY, came under light coaxing three furlongs out, shook away steadily to the quarter pole, got set down at that station swinging from the two path into upper stretch, dug in to inch away to the eighth pole drifting in a path under off sided stick work, came under a vigorous hand ride through the final sixteenth to repulse a steady gain and prevail on the wire holding well to the end. WHITE ROSE saved ground towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home, rode the rail into prominence nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch under a drive, angled out nearing the furlong grounds as the aforementioned rival drifted in slightly, rallied steadily gaining through to the wire but was ultimately staved off while safe for the place honors. SCAMPERING off half a beat slow as she tossed her head at the start, settled two to three wide towards the rear, got lightly coaxed along near the three-eighths before being put to further encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide for home, offered up mild late energy to secure the show inside the final sixteenth. GEISHA GAL four wide through the first turn, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, made a four wide bid through the turn into contention, shifted in a path to swing two to three wide for home, bid mildly to the eighth pole, flattened out in the late stages well clear for the last major share. MALIBU HOLIDAY three to four wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs out, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide into the stretch and weakened in the drive. GREED AND FEAR attended the pace from the three path, came under coaxing to apply pressure at the seven-sixteenths, retreated in the latter portion of the turn and tired. CASH FOR CLUNKERS away well, was eased back to track the pace along the inside, got ridden along nearing the three-eighths pole, faded through the latter part of the turn and was not persevered with in the stretch.
