1 $\frac{1}{4}$  MILES. (Turf) (1.382) STAKES. Purse \$65,000 *GOOD MOOD S. FOR FILLIES TWO YEAR OLDS.* No nomination fee. \$1,000 to enter, starters to receive a \$750 rebate. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at time of entry. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming, 2 lbs. Maidens, 3 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 21, 2009 with 24 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, Two-Year-Old races will be run at One Mile and races for Three-Year-Olds and Up will be run at One Mile and One Sixteenth on the main track.). (Clear 60)

CAMINADORA was outrun after breaking a bit slowly, rallied along the rail on the turn, swung three wide entering the stretch and closed late to gain the place. MS. THANKSGIVING broke inward at the start, set the pace while being pressed by the winner into upper stretch and weakened. KHANCORD KID raced just off the pace three wide to the top of the stretch and lacked a late response. AGAPANTHA checked at the start and failed to threaten thereafter. SPEIGHTFUL LADY was in hand early, saved ground to the turn, swung out and lacked a further response.
