5 FURLONGS. (Turf) (.533) STAKES. Purse \$60,000 *GULFSTREAM PARK TURF SPRINT S. FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD* . Free nomination by Saturday January 8, 2011, \$600 to pass the entry box and \$300 additional to start, with \$60,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$36,000, \$12,000 to second, \$6,000 to third, \$3,000 to fourth, \$1,800 to fifth and \$1,200 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry for a fee of \$3,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight 124 lbs: Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf since July 1, 2 lbs.; A graded stakes or \$45,000 twice in 2010-2011 allowed 4 lbs; \$30,000 since October 5, 6 lbs.; Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with A Iso Eligibles. Preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 8, 2011 with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs) (Rail at 12 feet). (Clear 67)

STRADIVINSKY chased the pace, moved up to engage RETIRE TO WHAT at the quarter pole, took over from that rival at the eighth pole and was all out to prevail. GREAT ATTACK broke awkwardly, chased the leaders into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while closing to prove second best. AHVEE'S DESTINY tracked the leaders along the inside into the stretch, eased out and couldn't gain late. RETIRE TO WHAT set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged by STRADAVINSKY on the turn, stayed with that rival to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. CARTE BLANCHE was not a factor.
