five wide at the quarter pole then was gaining ground in late stretch to finish well. HADACURE was bumped and pinched back at the start then made a mild rally while three wide in the stretch but was no threat. PRIMED PIONEER broke out and bumped at the start then raced on the

inside on the turn and made a mild gain in the stretch. VALID COCOA chased the early pace while racing four wide on the turn then weakened in the stretch drive. FLYERMAN failed to respond when asked.
