HOGY moved to the fore between foes in the opening stages, conceded the lead to track just off the eventual winner under light rating racing to the turn, was urged to lodge a brief bid outside that foe nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while losing the place honors late. LAHSHAD,

reserved to be last while angling over racing to the turn, saved ground on the turn gaining some position, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch but lacked a final response. STORMY PACIFIC, in touch with the leaders three deep between foes tracking the pace, continued in that path into the bend and faded between foes racing into upper stretch. AGENT DI NOZZO, caught four wide between foes tracking the leaders in second flight racing to the turn, steadily faded nearing the lane. EMPIRESTRIKESAGAIN, caught six wide early, continued five deep racing into the turn and soon retreated.
