Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Jan), by Broken Vow - After Thought by Fusaichi Pegasus. Trainer Oliver H. Victoria. Bred by G. Watts Humphrey Jr., Susie Keller, Vicki Oliver & G. Watts Humphrey III (KY).

ANNULMENT was rated in hand dropping just out of striking distance tracking the leaders outside a rival to the backstretch, steadily drew into range shifting three deep on the far turn, was prompted to challenge in that path racing through upper stretch and continued in a protracted skirmish to narrowly prevail in time under firm right handed encouragement. TEMPERS FLAIR was urged to gain a forward placing to stalk just off the pacesetter under light rating early, steadily advanced on that foe to challenge for command between rivals racing into upper stretch, continued to dispute the end and was just outfinished. V V GOODNIGHT was settled between foes in the last flight early, continued under patient handling into the far turn while dropping into last, split foes while shifting off the inside racing into upper stretch, angled four deep in late stages and was making solid progress nearing the wire. ZUBI ZUBI ZU moved to the fore outside foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail once gaining a clear advantage to dictate the pace under rating, continued to hold sway on a diminishing margin racing into upper stretch, shifted outwards a bit while being roused to resist several challengers to the inside and continued gamely to the end while just failing to contain the top trio. HIGH WIRE KITTEN, bumped, then steadied a bit in tight quarters a the start, was pulling a bit tracking the leaders near the inside racing into the far turn, shifted out three deep on the far turn while being urged to advance in close quarters between foes, exchanged some contact with COLONEL JOAN nearing upper stretch, was fanned five wide in late stages and had no final kick. FONEPFERESH (IRE) broke outwards crossing the path of HIGH WIRE KITTEN, was righted to track just off the leaders along the inside racing to the far turn but had no closing bid. COLONEL JOAN settled three wide in the last flight early, was urged to gain a closer position racing four wide into the far turn, was bumped while being steadied out of tight quarters nearing upper stretch and had no further response. SHARE THE SUGAR, shuffled a bit in close quarters just after the break, was reserved while switching outside foes racing through the backstretch, was fanned widest racing through the far turn and steadily faded in the drive.
