MISTER MARTI GRAS was settled out of striking distance while angling inside early, shifted off the inside gathering momentum on the far turn, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady late bid to prevail for the place honors. CALL ME GEORGE broke inwards bumping a rival, shifted in to track off the first flight between foes racing to the far turn, switched out to bid four deep racing into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was just outfinished for second. EFFINEX broke outwards bumping STREET SPICE, was righted to gain a position near the inside as part of the second flight, was urged to advance in close quarters racing through the stretch but lacked the needed final kick. EVER RIDER (ARG) was urged to gain a forward placing three deep, was bumped by ABRAHAM racing into the first turn, continued with a steady effort to challenge three deep between foes nearing upper stretch but faded between foes late.
