IOTAPA had speed inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid outside the runner-up leaving the second turn, took a short lead in upper stretch, shifted out from the whip in midstretch and again in deep stretch but gamely prevailed under urging. BROKEN SWORD sped to the early lead outside the winner, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the fence into the stretch, fought back inside through a long drive and went willingly to the wire. PARRANDA bobbed at the start, settled outside a rival then three deep on the second turn, angled in alongside a foe into the stretch and gained the show. FIFTYSHADESOFHAY saved ground chasing the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MORE CHOCOLATE broke a step slowly, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and gave way. DOINGHARDTIMEAGAIN stalked the pace outside a rival then between horses on the second turn, also dropped back into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
