SHOWING UP stalked off the rail then outside on the backstretch, went three deep into the second turn, bid four wide leaving that turn, took the lead approaching midstretch and pulled clear under some left handed urging. OBRIGADO (FR) angled in and saved ground off the pace, split rivals on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place. IVAN DENISOVICH (IRE) chased three deep then outside a rival, came out in the stretch and just got the show. CRESTED (GB) stalked inside then outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn, gained the advantage into the stretch and was edged for third late. ZANN chased outside a rival then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. KIP DEVILLE pulled his way along to duel outside a rival, was between horses nearing the quarter pole, found the inside in the stretch and weakened. FROST GIANT chased between horses then a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DARK ISLANDER (IRE) pulled his way along to duel inside, took the lead into the backstretch, battled along the rail, fell back some at the quarter pole and weakened. BIG MISTAKE pulled between horses then angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and also weakened. VEGA'S LORD (GER) close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
