Purse \$250,000 **HOLLYWOOD DERBY (GRADE 1) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS.** By subscription of \$400 each on or before Friday, August 5, 2011 which should accompany the nomination. Closed with 29. (No sustaining payments) Late nominations, for horses not previously nominated, may be made on or before Friday, October 7, 2011 by payment of \$2,000 each, which should accompany the nomination. Closed with 7. Late nominations, for horses not previously nominated, may be made on or before Thursday, November 17, 2011 by payment of \$5,000 each, which should accompany the nomination, of which \$4,000 is refundable if the nominee is entered and does not draw into the body of the race or if nominee is not entered and a veterinarian certificate is produced indicating the horse is unfit to run. Closed with 7. All nominees to pay \$2,000 to enter and an additional \$2,000 to start. Gross purse \$250,000 of which \$150,000 to be paid to the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner and trainer. (Clear 75)

ULTIMATE EAGLE sent along wide in the chute, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away approaching the first turn, responded when challenged again leaving the second turn, inched away in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. IMAGINING pulled early, bid between horses then outside the winner, stalked just off the rail, bid again on the second turn, had that rival inch away in the stretch but continued willingly to the wire. WESTERN ARISTOCRAT chased outside a rival then inside leaving the second turn, came out some in the stretch and also went on willingly between foes late. SLUMBER (GB) settled inside then a bit off the rail, split horses then came out on the second turn, angled four wide into the stretch and finished well. VENOMOUS (GB) chased outside a rival then between horses, found the rail on the second turn, moved up inside into the stretch and was outfinished. CASINO HOST chased three deep, was in a bit tight off heels early on the second turn, angled in outside a rival and finished with interest between foes late. COZY KITTEN angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and was outfinished in the final furlong. WILLCOX INN angled in and raced unhurried toward the inside for six furlongs, steadied and was forced out around CLOUD MAN early on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. IRISH ART four wide leaving the chute, stalked outside a rival then three deep, continued three wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. SURREY STAR (IRE) between horses early, angled in and stalked the pace inside, dropped back between horses into the stretch, was eased through the final furlong and vanned off after returning to be unsaddled. CLOUD MAN chased inside then a bit off the rail, was between horses leaving the backstretch and broke down early on the second turn and also was vanned off.
