Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, December 29, 2011 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: Three-Year-Olds 123 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2011 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice in 2011, 4 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2011. RIVER BEAR within striking distance, moved out five wide when rallying to the leaders late on the turn, took over once in the stretch and drew off under steady urging. LIVE FROM APPOLLO outrun off the inside, advanced in that path leaving the turn, angled out in midstretch and finished willingly to be up for the place late. CONCHACER alternated for the lead off the inside, battled into the stretch and tired late. GOLDEN COUNTRY forced the pace four wide, held on well to the final furlong and tired. MATTHEWSBURG angled out when outrun early, commenced his rally six wide on the turn, was fanned eight wide into the stretch, made a good run to the final furlong but went evenly late. TAPTOWNE close up along the inside, came off the rail for the drive and tired. EL GRAN SOL reserved early, raced five wide into the stretch and could not threaten. OUR ROCK STAR prompted the pace three wide, came six wide into the stretch and gave way. PATHOKI close up outside rivals, came seven wide late on the turn and faded. HOLLYWOOD HIT stumbled at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, was four wide late on the turn and gave way. TOO WILD FOR WORDS alternated for the lead three wide and stopped.
