came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and finished well for the place. THE GOLDEN NOODLE pulled early, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. SET PLAY three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FOXY DANSEUR saved ground stalking the pace, bid along

the rail in the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. TIME REVEALS ALL had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, regained the lead into the stretch, battled between horses in midstretch and also weakened. SUNDAY GEISHA chased between horses then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GRACE ANATOMY saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SPRITELY bobbled slightly at the start, had speed inside and dueled for the lead, fought back on

the second turn, steadied while weakening in upper stretch and gave way.
