Chestnut Filly, (Apr), by Pollard's Vision - Lucky One by Best of Luck. Trainer Hollendorfer Jerry. Bred by Fairlawn Farm(KY).

BLIND LUCK chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out a bit on the second turn, waited briefly then angled out for room leaving the turn, came four wide into the stretch, swept to the front nearing midstretch, drew clear while drifting in some and proved best under a brisk hand ride and a long hold late. MISS HEATHER LEE saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, split horses past midstretch, angled back inside and gained the place. AMEN HALLELUJAH three deep into and on the first turn, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, was no match for the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished for second. IT TIZ threw her head and steadied a bit just after the start, settled slightly off the rail, went up three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BICKERSONS stalked between horses or outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. ROSE CATHERINE pulled her way to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then angled in, dueled leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. BEAUTICIAN four wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, dropped back between horses on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
