STREAMING bumped at the start, had speed four wide then stalked off the rail on the first turn, bid alongside the runner-up to duel for the lead on the backstretch and second turn, took the advantage in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and won clear under urging. TASTE LIKE CANDY bumped lightly between horses at the start, sped to the early lead, dueled inside the winner on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch, could not quite match that one in the final furlong but gamely held second. UNTAPABLE chased three deep then outside a rival or off the rail, split horses on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and just held third. ROSALIND four wide into the first turn, angled in some and settled off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and just missed the show. ARETHUSA broke out, bumped the winner and steadied, angled in and saved ground off the pace, went around a rival leaving the second turn, angled back to the inside into the stretch and bested the others. BAJAN between horses early, chased outside a rival, went up three deep then four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. BE PROUD bumped lightly at the start, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival into the second turn and between foes on that turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. CONCAVE bumped lightly at the start, saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
