Gray or Roan Gelding, (Apr), by Verglas (IRE) - Misskinta (IRE) by Desert Sun (GB). Trainer Gallagher Patrick. Bred by Mrs Cherry Faeste (IRE).

GRANDEUR (IRE) stalked inside then a bit off the rail, continued between horses leaving the backstretch and into the last turn, came out for room into the stretch, rallied under urging to the front nearing the sixteenth pole and held on gamely. INTERACTION (ARG) saved ground chasing the pace, slipped through inside into the stretch, bid along the rail past the eighth pole and continued willingly to the wire. OPTIMIZER took the early lead along the inside then relinquished the advantage in the stretch the first time, stalked inside, came out into the stretch, was in tight between foes in midstretch but outfinished rivals for the show. SLIM SHADEY (GB) stalked the early pace then took command outside a rival in the stretch the first time and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and final turn, inched away a bit off the rail in the stretch, was between horses past the eighth pole and weakened late. FIRE WITH FIRE stalked inside then outside a rival, bid alongside SLIM SHADY on the backstretch and final turn and weakened in the final furlong. BOURBON BAY saved ground off the pace, swung out into the stretch and improved position. TIZ GIANNI angled in and raced unhurried outside a rival most of the way to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GRASSY chased between foes on the first turn then outside the winner, went three deep on the last turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. KINDERGARDEN KID stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out three wide on the final turn, drifted inward in the lane and weakened. PRIVATE AFFAIR (PER) angled in and settled just off the rail then outside a rival, found the inside into the stretch and was not a threat.
