Closed with 19. All nominees to pay \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start. Gross purse \$150,000 of which \$90,000 to be paid to the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$18,000 to third, \$9,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. es the right not to divide this race. Should this race not be divided and the number of entries exceed twelve (12), highweights on the weight scale will be preferred. Total earnings in 2006 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assign ed equal weights on the scale. Entry fees will be refunded to all horses which fail to draw into this race. JUNGLE PRINCE angled in and dueled outside a rival, gained the advantage into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and held gamely under urging. IN SUMMATION was in a good position stalking the pace outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch and finished willingly. MOTH BALL (GB) pulled a bit early, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and also went on willingly between foes late. OSIDY squeezed a bit at the start, settled outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. SHERWOOD PARK stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, found the rail in the stretch, had the rider lose the whip late and lacked the needed final response. HOUSEOFROYALHEARTS angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary rally. CAPTAIN KURT (NZ) off a bit slowly, pulled his way up inside to stalk the pace, waited a bit off heels leaving the turn and into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and weakened late. LAZZERI had speed between horses then dueled inside to the stretch and also weakened.
