Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Feb), by Arch - Eximius (GB) by Atticus. Trainer Mandella E. Richard. Bred by Wertheimer et Frere(KY). SARACH had speed outside then angled in and set the pace inside, responded when challenged into and on the second turn and into the stretch, inched away again in midstretch and held gamely under urging. SCARLET STRIKE unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail early, trailed just off the inside, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. MACHA pulled inside early, stalked along the rail then a bit off the fence, bid outside the winner into and on the second turn and into the stretch and just held third. BECKY LOU pulled between horses then went three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, split foes into the stretch, was bumped between horses in midstretch, came out and finished well. CHARLIE EM (GB) angled in and chased outside a rival then between horses into and on the second turn, came out three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. SOMETHINGABOUTHER saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked the needed late kick. WITTGENSTEIN (IRE) pulled her way between horses then chased outside a rival, found the inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out and bumped a rival nearing midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. KYRIAKI pulled early, angled in and stalked outside a rival then off the rail, went three deep on the second turn, fell back some leaving that turn, came three wide into the stretch, steadied in traffic after dropping back nearing midstretch and weakened.
