presented a seam nearing the final furlong, came through to wear down the determined leader and get up on the wire to prevail in the last jumps. CLASSIC POINT coaxed from the get go to cut the pace inside, got roused under pressure at the top of the stretch while cutting the

MUNNINGS SISTER away alertly and hustled from the start despite breaking a step outwards, got taken in hand and eased back to avoid contesting the pace, settled three to four wide in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three to four wide into the

stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. PROMISE ME A CAT saved ground towards the rear, came under urging at the

corner, inched away to the furlong marker, dug in stubborn and defiant but was wore down in the final stride and nailed on the wire.

BURBAN chased the pace from just off the inside coaxed along from three furlongs out lightly, got set down at the head of the stretch, fought on mildly to the eighth pole before weakening in the final furlong. LIVI MAKENZIE in hand tracking the pace initially down along the rail, shifted

five-sixteenths, angled to be four wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild bid in the late stages to garner the last major share.
