**7 FURLONGS. (1.20<sup>2</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 HOPEFUL S. (GRADE I) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$3,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$6,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the close of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 which will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a Graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2013. 120 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 17, 2013 with 30 Nominations. (Cloudy 78)**

**Bay Colt, (Feb), by Tiznow - Clear Mandate by Deputy Minister. Trainer Lukas Wayne D.. Bred by G. Watts Humphrey Jr.(KY).**

**STRONG MANDATE** broke out at the start, was never far back while racing on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch under one crack of a right-handed whip, quickly moved clear, drifted out a path or two when given one crack of a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths, switched back to the right-hand and was given one final crack at the eighth-pole, powered further away from the rest of the field under a hand ride and was geared down in the final sixteenth in a big performance.

**CASIGUAPO** was urged along while just off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and secured the place while no match for the winner. **LUNARWARFARE** bumped solidly with a rival at the start, was urged along while amongst horses, went three wide on the turn, drifted out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and got up for the show. **BIG SUGAR SODA** bumped solidly with **LUNARWARFARE** at the start, was ridden along at the back, raced off the rail on the turn and improved position without threatening. **WIRED BRYAN** brushed with an opponent at the start, pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, dropped back a bit at the half-mile pole, chased off the rail on the turn and tired. **LONG ON VALUE** was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn and came up empty. **ALL IN BLUE** was coaxed along between rivals, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to respond. **KING CYRUS** was carried out at the start, raced on the outside while ridden along, went five then four wide on the turn and was no factor. **CORFU** showed good speed, set the pace under some pressure, moved clear with a half-mile to run, vied inside on the turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, lost the lead near the quarter-pole and gave way. **SOUTHERN BLESSING** was urged along towards the back, saved ground on the turn and never reached contention.
