PALACE took up position in midpack after getting away in good order, was unhurried while chasing the front runners from the two path, picked up interest when asked prior to the quarter pole, swung four wide into the lane while asked for his best, closed in readily on the runner up to loom a serious threat with a furlong remaining, got herded out steadily by that opponent shortly afterwards, rubbed shoulders and brushed with MOONLIGHT SONG while taking over in the final seventy yards, continued onward with good courage and shook free. MOONLIGHT SONG sat patiently parked in the three path while pressing the issue as the widest of a trio, ranged up to make his presence more pronounced after going halfway around the bend, poked a head down in the front heading into the stretch still at this stage unasked for run, had that occur after going a couple of additional jumps, started the last eighth leading by a slight advantage and with the eventual winner to the outside full of momentum and bearing down hard, began to drift outward towards the middle of strip, lost the lead anyway, made light contact with the top one in the late stages en route to being second best. B SHANNY broke alertly and gained the early lead, was sent over to the inside, rated kindly while showing the way, being pressed by another pair, likewise rated, to his outside, had already fallen back by a very slight margin when called upon spinning into the lane, failed to re claim the front despite fighting with some determination, weakened steadily once by the eighth pole into the show slot. MINE OVER MATTER made it over to the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, stayed glued along the inside route for almost the entire way around the turn, got angled three wide into the stretch, came up empty. CAY TO POMEROY contested the pace from between rivals from the five-sixteenths pole to upper stretch before giving way. NIGHT MANEUVER got off two beats behind the penultimate breaker after striking the right side of the gate, was three wide entering the turn and six wide exiting it, made no impact.
