B SHANNY broke alertly and gained the early lead, was sent over to the inside, rated kindly while showing the way, being pressed by another pair, likewise rated, to his outside, had already fallen back by a very slight margin when called upon spinning into the lane, failed to re claim the front despite fighting with some determination, weakened steadily once by the eighth pole into the show slot. MINE OVER MATTER made it over to the rail at the nine-sixteenths pole, stayed glued along the inside route for almost the entire way around the turn, got angled three wide into the stretch, came up empty.
