WILDCAT RED was prompted to gain a position three deep tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight in the opening stages, made a steady advance in that path on the turn to draw on terms with the leader nearing upper stretch, took over from that foe entering the lane and drew away smartly in the final stages under hand urging while his rider flashed a right handed whip to prove clearly best. C. ZEE, a bit slow to gather stride, was urged between foes to gain a position in the second flight tracking the pacesetter racing to the turn, continued under steady pressure while shifting out racing into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner's kick but prevailed for the place honors. PABLO DEL MONTE was guided to the rail early while being rated just off the second flight, shifted off the inside gaining some position between foes racing into the bend, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out three deep to split foes in that path while being roused to gain some position but lacked the needed final kick while being outfinished for second. LONG ON VALUE tracked just off the second four deep between foes in the opening stages, was urged to advance in that path racing into the bend, was fanned five wide entering the lane and steadily faded in late stages. SPOT shifted off the inside early gaining a position off the second flight, was urged to advance three deep between racing into the turn, shifted out four wide in the lane and gave way between foes in the final stages. TASHIR was settled last while angling to the inside racing into the turn, switched off the inside, then angled widest racing through the stretch gaining some position late while making no real impression. MIGHTY BROWN broke readily to gain a position just off the pacesetter along the inside stalking that foe racing along the rail into the turn, but gave way racing into upper stretch. TRAIL BLAZE raced five deep tracking off the second flight in the opening stages and offered no rally. GAMBLER'S GHOST broke sharply to gain the advantage, shifted nearer to the inside to dictate the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the rail racing into the turn, set the pace through the bend and gave out once headed by the winner entering upper stretch.
