1 1/4 MILES. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *INDIANA DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$400 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start. With \$500,000 added, After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Fillies: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at one mile or over in 2009, 3 lbs.; of \$30,000 at any distance in 2009 5 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs.; two such races, 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing (72 Hour Closing). Trophy to the winning owner. High weights preferred. NOTE: This stake will be limited to twelve starters. If more than twelve horses pass the entry box, preference will be (1) High weights; (2) Highest Lifetime Earnings. Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Entry fee only will be refunded if failure to draw into the race. (Cloudy 70)

Chestnut Ridgling, (Apr), by Candy Ride (ARG) - Beyond Perfection by Quack. Trainer Baffert Bob. Bred by Bob Baffert(KY). MISREMEMBERED stalked the pace early from the three path, stayed in the three path in the far turn, took over command in the stretch, drew clear late and held in the final stages. GIANT OAK was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn, rallied quickly in the stretch run but did not have enough as he approached the finish. KARAMA tracked the pace early while on the inside into the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out in the final stages. WESLINN set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch drive. WIN WILLY was back early, angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. FUNDY was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn and lacked a needed bid in the stretch. SUMO chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn while making a bid but faded late in the stretch drive. DESPITE THE ODDS angled off the rail into the far turn while no threat late. FLAT BOLD raced up close early, was between horses in the far turn, steadied inside the five sixteenth pole and soon retreated.
