EL ROBLAR chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch, gained the lead outside the pacesetter in upper stretch and held on gamely under urging. HEROI DO BAFRA (BRZ) chased between foes early then outside a rival, angled out into the stretch, bid outside the winner in the drive and continued willingly to the wire. UFFIZI settled inside, swung out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and finished with interest. GET FUNKY chased outside a rival then inside, came out and was in a bit tight off heels in upper stretch, continued between horses in midstretch and was outfinished. HELLO SUNDAY (FR) three deep early, angled in and chased a bit off the rail then inside, swung out into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary response. MR NAPPER TANDY (GB) a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came out a bit into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GHOSTTRAPPER pulled his way to the early lead, drifted out a bit into the first turn, opened a commanding advantage while setting the pace along the inside but had little left for the stretch.
