WONDER OF IT ALL was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, responded when put to pressure with five-sixteenths to run, swung to the outside entering the stretch, quickened in the final furlong and was up in the final strides. TROIS FAMILLE was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a bold bid, finished well but was denied in the final stride. QUEEN OF FORTUNE pressed the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MAKENZIE'S MAGIC settled in hand, advanced between horses, was hemmed in through the drive and flattened out. I REMEMBER WHEN stalked the pace three wide, forged a brief lead, but weakened during the drive and faded. DIAMOND EXCHANGE was allowed to settle off of the inside, angled out to make a mild bid four wide but came up empty entering the stretch. MI MARGARITA opened clear to set the pace, was collared between horses on the second turn, checked hard with a quarter to run and stopped thereafter. SASSY SECRETARY showed little. The Jockey of MAKENZIE'S MAGIC lodged an objection against TROIS FAMILLE for alleged interference in the drive, but following a Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
