1 1/8 MILES. (1.404) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 IOWA OAKS (GRADE III) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES. Weights: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at one mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; non-winners of \$40,000 in 2010 allowed 6 lbs.; non-winners of \$20,000 in 2010 allowed 9 lbs. No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start. \$200,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH A FEE OF \$4,000 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds fourteen (14), high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. (Clear 88)

SEEKING THE TITLE stalked the early pace from the inside, dropped back slightly up the backstretch, crept forward entering the stretch while just off the rail, altered outside mid stretch and was just up the final yards. HARISSA up close early while outside rivals, chased the early leader up the backstretch, inched closer entering the second turn, responded when asked entering the drive, gained a short advantage at the eighth pole but was outfinished in a game effort. ALL DUE RESPECT broke sharp from between foes to gain a clear early margin, held a clear margin up the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn, held a forward position into the drive but could not keep pace. QUIET TEMPER up close early while inside, altered course outside entering the backstretch, pressed the pace up the backstretch, remained forward for the drive but had nothing left. REMIT forced the early pace from the inside, but had nothing left for the drive. SHOTGUN GULCH never far back, had no late response.
