(GRADE III) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$100 each or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstakes, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Iroquois will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 10, 2012 with 48 nominations. (Cloudy 50)

**Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Mar), by Lion Heart - Captivating by Arch. Trainer Casse E. Mark. Bred by William D. Graham(ON). UNCAPTURED** within striking distance between rivals, steadied in traffic into the turn, recovered, was patiently handled around the bend, angled out for the drive, surged to the lead in midstretch and drew off under steady urging. **POSITIVELY** reserved early, made a bold five wide move on the turn, challenged approaching the stretch, could not cope with the winner in midstretch but held on to be second best. **OVERANALYZE** with the early pace outside rivals, lost position into the turn, moved out five wide with less than three furlongs to go and improved his position while no threat. **STRIKE THE NOTE** forced the early pace, dropped back a bit four wide on the turn then had no late bid. **PATAKY KID** hopped a bit at the start, was outrun, raced in the four path on the turn, angled out for the drive and showed some late interest. **FIVE IRON** forwardly placed, was in tight into the turn then was no threat late. **HEAVEN'S RUNWAY** vied for the lead three wide, came in a bit into the turn, stayed on well to the final furlong and tired. **TRIPLE CROSS** outrun off the inside, was no factor. **AGAVE CAT** within striking distance along the inside, tired. **ROAD AGENT** alternated for the lead off the snide and stopped in the drive.
