Gray or Roan Horse, (Mar), by Giacomo - Tizprecious by Jade Hunter. Trainer Jacobson David. Bred by Adena Springs(FL). TIZ GIANNI underwent a three wide journey, bid coming to the five-sixteenths marker, kicked clear after entering the turn, and remained sufficiently so to the end. ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS established control soon after the start, proved ratable cutting the pace from the two path, began to display an inclination to drift outward coming to the end of the backstretch, had the winner challenge in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, yielded but finished willingly enough to secure second. SON OF A GENERAL raced three to four wide, got asked for run by the midway point on the second bend, lacked a solid late offering. KISS OF THUNDER stumbled at the start, was strung out three wide on the opening bend, worked his way towards the inside by the next one, was under strong handling entering the lane, made no impact. WAYWARD SAILOR bobbed at the start, sat forwardly placed from off the inside, swung three wide into the lane, tired. HAILSTONE quickly tucked along the inside, saved ground for nearly three-quarters, commenced the stretch four wide to no avail. WHERE'S DANNY (IRE) saved ground and was outrun. MOST HAPPY FELLA three wide on each bend, gave way. KENTUCKY PIE tracked the front runners from the inside in the early going, slipped into the two path nearing the far turn, had no rally. PLEIADIAN stumbled badly at the start, unseating the rider. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
