QUALITY ROAD angled in a bit soon after the start, pressed the pace under a firm hold while well off the rail on the backstretch, took the lead nearing the half mile pole, dug in when threatened on the turn, drifted wide entering the stretch, fought gamely inside the winner into midstretch then yielded grudgingly in the late stages.
