1 MILE 70 YARDS. (1.384) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *JEROME S. (GRADE III) INNER DIRT FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* h the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2015 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The Jerome has also been selected as one of the races in the Kentucky Derby Championship Series Prep Season. The winner of the Jerome will be awarded 10 points, the second place finisher 4 points, the third place finisher 2 points and the fourth place finisher 1 point. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake or \$60,000 other than state bred allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstake or two races other than maiden, claiming or starter, 5 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Rainy 36)

EL KABEIR four to three wide through the first turn, settled three wide in close aim of the leader rating kindly in hand, remained patiently handled attending a pair to the outside through to nearing the quarter pole when put to a vigorous hand ride swinging three wide into upper stretch, rallied collaring NASA and taking over with three-sixteenths remaining, moved down to the fence and edged away under a vigorous hand ride receiving a single off sided stick near the sixteenth marker and was ridden out to the finish. NASA bobbed slightly at the start requiring some coaxing to be forwardly placed just off the inside between foes into the backside, got coaxed along lightly applying some pressure to OSTROLENKA down the back straightaway, came under urging in full challenge midway on the turn, took over narrowly and briefly at the head of the stretch, dug in and was collared three-sixteenths from home, proved no match for the top one late while well clear for the place and second best on this day. GENERAL BELLAMY lost his footing at the start getting away last and conceding three lengths to the front, saved ground through the first turn before shifting to race two to three wide detached from the main body of the field as the backmarker, got spirited up three furlongs out, circled weakening foes through the latter portion of the far turn to spin three wide for home, kept on through the stretch by tired rivals to garner the show honors. ACKERET just off the inside just off the pace, shifted to the rail for the run around the far turn with seven-sixteenths remaining, came under encouragement midway on the turn and spun just off the inside for home, then tired in the drive. OSTROLENKA in hand on the pace along the inside under attendance from a pair in close aim, came under increasing pressure from NASA from five furlongs out, got coaxed along three furlongs out, yielded command just prior to cutting the corner into upper stretch and folded. MINI COSMO saved ground in mid pack, briefly checked at the seven-sixteenths as ACKERET shifted to the rail in front, came under coaxing through the far turn, spun four wide into upper stretch and tired. NOW WE ARE FREE three to four wide through the first turn, chased three to four wide from midpack, gave way after a half. ROYAL BURGH brushed the off side stall at the start, chased three wide under coaxing, retreated after a half.
