VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) settled outside a rival then just off the rail on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place late. LUCAYAN (FR) unhurried and angled in outside a rival early, found the inside on the second turn, rallied along the rail in the stretch then came out in deep stretch and just got the show. OLD TIME HOCKEY three deep early, chased outside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch and finished willingly between foes late. TEAKS NORTH pulled his way along to duel inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid again outside a foe on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead in the drive, was between foes past midstretch and was outfinished. SLIM SHADEY (GB) a bit wide on the hill, angled in and dueled outside a rival then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back on the second turn and until past midstretch and weakened late. KETTLE CORN settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
