UNITARIAN briefly placed on the inside route during the prolonged straightaway run leading up to the opening bend, chose the two path as the one to take around it, briefly re-tucked along the rail after entering the backstretch, was put to a long drive and unleashed a three wide on the far turn to advance into a strong striking position by the quarter pole, commenced the stretch four wide, made up minimal ground during the ensuing furlong, was more successfully thereafter, collaring the runner up in the final seventy yards, edged away, crossing the finish line under a vigorous hand ride. PARNELLI quickly established control, was comfortably rated along from the rail on an open for the initial three-quarters, had MR. JENNEY range up and issue a bid by the midway point on the second bend, got asked for a response in response to the challenge, staved it off, felt the top one's presence leaving the sixteenth marker, proved powerless to fend off that opponent and had to settle for being second best. MR. JENNEY sat forwardly placed from the three path, was let out a notch coming to the end of the backstretch to clear TIZ NASTY, tucked into the two path and sustaining his run went on to hook up to the second place finisher, kept the pressure on to upper stretch before backing away. FEDERAL AGENT placed into the four path and under encouragement coming to the five-sixteenths marker, lacked the needed response. IN ROCKY'S HONOR broke outward, making contact with the starting gate then bobbling right afterwards, saved ground until midway down the backstretch, failed to reaching a contending position. RAKETE tracked from the inside, faltered. TIZ NASTY (IRE) stalked the leader from the outside, got replaced in that role by MR. JENNEY in the vicinity of the half mile pole, went onward for another furlong before getting guided to the rail, gave way. SUPREME COMMANDER off to a sluggish start, saved ground to the quarter pole.
