Bay Filly, (Mar), by Bernstein - Life Happened by Stravinsky. Trainer Mark E. Casse. Bred by Machmer Hall (KY).

TEPIN three to four wide in aim of the front, got set down four wide into upper stretch, rallied to get latched on DISCREET MARQ inside the eighth pole, took over just inside the final sixteenth coming under late threat from FILIMBI and prevailed as that foe latched on at the wire. FILIMBI bursted the off side stall at the start, settled in reserve two to three wide just off the pace behind the cover of COFFEE CLIQUE, came under brief coaxing three furlongs out before being placed back in hand off the heels of the leaders, swung three wide into upper stretch in behind a trio of rivals, angled out once clear to the outside to the four path a furlong out, kicked on belatedly to threaten and get latched on in the last jumps but was held off. DISCREET MARQ rated just off the hedge trading the front with COFFEE CLIQUE to the outside, remained patiently handled until set down spinning just off the inside for home, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole coming under threat at that marker, dug in and was displaced inside the sixteenth pole and ran on for the show honors. LADY LARA (IRE) just off the inside in mid pack early, settled near the rear after the opening quarter mile, came under urging with five-sixteenths to run, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. SANDIVA (IRE) bobbed slightly at the start, recovered to tracked the pace along the inside in aim of the front and behind the cover of the leader, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, swung just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on through the lane but was outkicked. COFFEE CLIQUE a bit keen in the early going fighting the rating of the rider and stargazing a bit, settled three wide trading the front with DISCREET MARQ to her inside while in hand, came under light coaxing with five-sixteenths to run before being roused three wide into upper stretch, battled on to the eighth pole before weakening in the late stages. J WONDER four wide in reserve near the rear, got spirited up three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. BALL DANCING four wide in pursuit throughout, got ridden along midway on the far turn, spun five wide into upper stretch shifting four wide straightened away and offered no response. BAFFLE ME three wide near the rear, came under urging with five-sixteenths to run, angled five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the lane. PHOTO CALL (IRE) five wide in mid pack, came under urging while taking the overland route midway on the far turn, swung seven wide at the head of the stretch and tired.
