(GRADE III) A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,500 rebate. This race includes an additional \$50,000 in Breeders' Cup Funds for Cup nominees only. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Trophy to the winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 19, 2009 with 29 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Clear 70)
